



## Township of Asphodel-Norwood Council Meeting Highlights

### Tuesday April 23, 2019

- 1st Quarter Updates for 2019 were presented from the Fire, Building, Parks & Recreation, Water/Wastewater, and Finance departments
- The Public Works department advised a return of the Hard Plastics Collection Program at the Asphodel-Norwood Transfer Station site this summer (June, July, and August)
- The Chief Building Official provided a Planning and Development Update report
- Council awarded RFT 2019-04, Gravel Crushing Tender to Drain Bros. Excavating
- Council directed staff to request the inclusion of provisional railing options in the Peterborough County Westwood Bridge Tender as they support in principle the second option proffered by HP Engineering to maintain the current paved roadway width of 6.1m, provide 1.5m raised platforms, widen the superstructure by 0.486m on each side, and include a 6-box girder cross-section
- Council approved the naming of 'Norwood Park' for the new park in the Norwood Park Estates Subdivision and 'Terry C. McIlwain' as the name for the new playground therein
- The CAO/Clerk/Treasurer advised Township rebranding efforts will commence shortly
- Township staff engaged in a friendly Earth Day competition to pick-up roadside litter as a team building event. Staff spent an enjoyable two (2) hours around the Township collecting 77 garbage bags, along with numerous other loose materials such as broken lawn chairs, a desk, drywall, cinder blocks, scrap steel, etc.
- Council approved a time change from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. for the special meeting of Council on May 16, 2019
- A public meeting was held respecting two (2) proposed Zoning By-Law Amendments for 67 Mill Street and 112 Mill Street from Rural Zone (RU) to Residential One Zone (R1). Council approved the Zoning By-Law Amendments with the passing of By-Laws 2019-26 and 2019-27
