- Laurie Inglis gave an update on Stewart House for Hospice Norwood
- Council recommended approval of two Consent Applications to the County of Peterborough Land Division
- Council authorized staff to enter into a two-year extension of the service agreement with Peterborough Utilities Group for on call and weekend coverage for water and wastewater plant operations
- Council authorized staff to enter into an agreement with Miller Paving for the completion of the Township's 2019 surface treatment program
- Council approved a licence agreement with the Royal Canadian Legion, Br. 300 for the erection of an illuminated sign
- Council approved a merger agreement with Meghan and Stephen Valentine
- Council authorized staff to enter into a five-year banking services contract with RBC Royal Bank
- Council proclaimed Saturday, June 1, 2019 as Trails Day at the Mill Pond Forest Trails
- In support of the Otonabee Region Conservation Authority's upcoming 60th anniversary, Council directed staff to prepare a donation gift basket representative of the Township
