



Township of Asphodel-Norwood Council Meeting Highlights

Tuesday May 28, 2019

- Barry Walsh was sworn into the Office of Councillor
- The Peterborough Regional Health Centre (PRHC) President/CEO and BOD Vice Chair delivered an update on how they are transforming care through investment and innovation
- Council awarded the Community Centre LED Lighting Tender (RFT 2019-06) to Swantech Energy Solutions
- Council elected to hold one meeting at the Westwood Library each year, commencing in 2020
- Council opted to appoint an alternate member (Councillor Warr) to Peterborough County Council in the event the Mayor or Deputy Mayor cannot be in attendance
- Council directed staff to revise the donation policy update to impose a \$500.00 annual limit per individual/group/individual and to exempt building permit and planning application fees from the donation policy application process
- Council adopted the new Committee & Board Appointment By-Law 2019-37
- Council supported the 3rd Annual Norwood Pride Event – flag will be raised during the afternoon of Friday July 5, 2019 and lowered on Monday July 15, 2019
- Council directed staff to prepare a report on the Transfer Station hours
- Council supported the Asphodel-Norwood Public Libraries' opposition to the SOLS cutbacks
- The CAO/Clerk/Treasurer advised that staff reports will be coming forward regarding the Library well in Westwood, water meter replacements and upgrades, and a request from Norwood & District Minor Ball
- Mayor Bonneau proclaimed June 1, 2019 as Trails Day
- Mayor Bonneau proclaimed the month of June as Seniors' month
- Council adopted the taxation By-Law 2019-20 as Amended
- Council authorized the execution of an Agreement between Peterborough Utilities Group (PUG) and the Corporation of the Township of Asphodel-Norwood through By-Law 2019-36
