## 1 Containers



### Glass

- ✓ Coloured and clear bottles and jars

### Plastic

- ✓ Food and drink containers, tubs and lids

### Metal

- ✓ Pop cans, pie plates and tin foil
- ✓ Food and drink cans and tins
- ✓ Empty metal paint cans, lids removed
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans

### Cartons and Cups

- ✓ Milk cartons and juice boxes
- ✓ Paper coffee cups

#### Do Not Include

- ✗ Ceramic or other dishes. Any broken glass.
- ✗ Motor oil containers, straws, toys.
- ✗ Scrap metal, utensils, pots and pans.
- ✗ Styrofoam of any kind.

## 2 Fibres



### Paper

- ✓ Newspaper, writing/office paper, magazines, telephone books, envelopes, junk mail and flyers, paper bags

### Boxes

- ✓ Flattened small boxes can be placed loose in bin. Large boxes can be bundled 30" x 30" x 8" and put beside bin.

### Other Fibres

- ✓ Paper tubes from toilet paper and paper towel

### Plastic Bags

- ✓ Film plastics, grocery, milk, bread bags – place all in one and tie

#### Do Not Include

- ✗ Chip bags, plastic stretch wrap, candy and cheese wrappers.
- ✗ Foil lined meal delivery boxes - place foil in garbage, then recycle box
- ✗ Liners from cracker/cereal boxes
